

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the next steps and resources needed to develop five- and twenty-year Mobility Investment Program (MIP) for transportation capital projects.

Recommendation for Council action:

RECEIVE and FILE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) dated June 12, 2020, relative to the next steps and resources needed to develop five- and twenty-year MIPs for transportation capital projects.

SUMMARY

In a report to Council dated June 12, 2020, LADOT discusses the next steps and resources needed to develop five- and twenty-year MIPs for transportation capital projects. LADOT created the MIP to improve project delivery and develop capital improvement plans for transportation investments. MIP benchmarks better position the City and LADOT to leverage funding opportunities to implement transportation investments that enhance the safety, sustainability, and reliability of the transportation system for all users. The MIP tracks, secures, and manages new and ongoing funding opportunities, which will minimize instances of transportation capital project funding gaps and result in more equitable outcomes.

The LADOT goes on to detail the project initiation process, identifying and securing project funding, and planning community engagement.

At its special meeting held June 19, 2020, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council receive and file the LADOT report.
