DISCUSSION

This donation will be used to benefit the officers at Wilshire Area. If approved, the donation would allow the Wilshire Area equipment lockers to be installed, replaced or repaired. The improvements will provide officers usable space to store duty equipment and improve the aesthetics of the existing duty equipment lockers. Management Analyst Lloyd Blum, Facilities Management Division (FMD), has reviewed the request and provided approval for the improvements of the facility to include the equipment lockers to be installed, replaced or repaired.

Ram Construction Services is a private organization who offered to assist Wilshire Division. This donation was not solicited by Wilshire Division.
