Los Angeles voters have demonstrated time and time again that they want more affordable housing. Please stand with them and stop the CGI Strategies project proposed for [623-671 S. La Brea Ave](#) which misuses the Transit Oriented Communities Program to create a project with more hotel rooms than actual housing.
