TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of Haskell Avenue and Bermuda Street.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Lee - Koretz):

- RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, to hereby prohibit
 the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height,
 during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along both sides of Haskell Avenue from
 Chatsworth Street to San Fernando Mission Boulevard, and along both sides of Bermuda
 Street from Haskell Avenue to Blucher Avenue.
- 2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specified hours detailed.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of said Resolution.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has submitted a financial analysis of this report.

<u>Community Impact Statement</u>: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On August 5, 2020, Council considered Resolution (Lee - Koretz) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along both sides of Haskell Avenue from Chatsworth Street to San Fernando Mission Boulevard, and both sides of Bermuda Street from Haskell Avenue to Blucher Avenue. The Resolution states that a commercial area of Chatsworth is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parked overnight adjacent to businesses and block travel lanes, thereby creating hazardous conditions. The Council referred the Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its regular meeting held on August 17, 2020, the Transportation Committee considered the Resolution and provided an opportunity for public comment. The Committee recommended that the Council approve the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to the Resolution. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
