Summary: Based on the 2020 Countywide homeless count, there are approximately 42,000 unhoused women, men and children in the City of Los Angeles; 29,000 are living on the streets, in cars or other locations not meant for human habitation. From January 1, 2020 to November 30, 2020, 1,248 of our unhoused community members have died. This is a 32 percent increase from 2019. The vast majority of persons experiencing homelessness in Los Angeles DO NOT WANT to live on the streets and NO humane society should allow its most vulnerable members to languish on the streets. The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) believes everyone has the right to a safe, affordable place to call home. UNNC supports the Comprehensive Crisis Response Strategy motion.
