Comments for Public Posting: Dear Councilmember, Thousands of hard-working Angelenos have lost their jobs. We need a strong worker retention law to make sure Angelenos can return to their jobs when the crisis ends. Employers are already taking advantage of the crisis. Workers at the Chateau Marmont, were initially promised that they would be able to keep their insurance during the layoff. However, only a day later, the company told workers their insurance would be cancelled, with no promises of a recall when the hotel recovers. After 9/11, the City of Santa Monica passed a worker retention law to ensure that hotel workers displaced by the economic impact of 9/11 could return to work in order of seniority when business returned. Please pass an LA worker retention law that will ensure workers return to work in order of seniority.
