I MOVE that the matter of the ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOBS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to reestablishing the moratorium on enforcing and issuing citations for vending without a valid license or permit for the duration of the COVID-19 State of Emergency and for six months thereafter, Item No. 30 on today's Council Agenda (C.F. 20-0147-S27), BE AMENDED to ADOPT the following in lieu of Recommendation No. 1 of the Committee Report:

1. RESCIND the Council action of March 17, 2020, which urged the Bureau of Street Services to immediately start enforcing its rules and regulations that prohibit street vending for food vendors who do not possess a valid health permit for the length of the current local emergency; and INSTRUCT BOSS to continue to only issue penalty-free notices of violation for sidewalk vending without a license or permit until January 1, 2022.
