Honorable Members:

This Office recommends that discussion with, and advice from, legal counsel for City Council be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Sections 54956.9(d)(1); (d)(2),(e)(1); and (d)(4). Government Code Section 54956.9(d) requires in this situation that you state publicly prior to the closed session what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation, a publicly known significant exposure to litigation, or the potential initiation of litigation.

The Council may recess to Closed Session, pursuant to Government Code Sections 54956.9(d)(1); (d)(2),(e)(1)(one potential case); and (d)(4)(one potential case). This matter concerns ongoing litigation, a significant exposure to litigation, and possible initiation of litigation with respect to the following matter: *LA Alliance for Human Rights, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al.*, United States Central District Court Case No. 2:20-cv-02291, Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals Case No. 22-55687, including but not limited to the Court's recent appointment of a Monitor in the settlement agreement for this matter, which concerns enjoining and compelling the City's response to homelessness.
