


RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Chief of Police, or his designee, to negotiate and execute the Fifth Amendment between the Los Angeles Police Department and GSG Protective Services CA, Inc. for security guard services. The Fifth Amendment will extend the term of the contract an additional two years from February 21, 2020 to February 20, 2022.

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) requests authority to execute the Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-128953 between the City of Los Angeles and GSG Protective Services CA, Inc. (formerly U.S. Metro Group, Inc.) for security guard services. The Fifth Amendment will extend the term of the contract an additional two years from February 21, 2020 to February 20, 2022.

The term of the original agreement was from February 21, 2017 through February 20, 2020. Subsequent to the original agreement, the contract was amended four times as follows: the First Amendment replaced Attachment C (Fee Schedule) of the original agreement with revised rates for FY 2017-18; the Second Amendment updated the City's Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3], replaced Attachment 1 (Fee Schedule) of the First Amendment with revised rates for FY 2018-19, and replaced Attachment B (Statement of Work) of the original agreement with revised minimum requirements for the Professional Security Officer position; the Third Amendment replaced

all references of "U.S. Metro Group, Inc." with "GSG Protective Services CA, Inc."; and, the Fourth Amendment replaced all references of "Cypress Private Security, L.P." with "Allied Universal Security Services" and also replaced Attachment 2 (Fee Schedule) of the Third Amendment with revised rates for FY 2019-20. The proposed Fifth Amendment will extend the duration of the contract an additional two years from February 21, 2020 to February 20, 2022.

The LAPD states that extending the term of the contract will allow the LAPD's Security Services Division sufficient time to conduct the Request for Proposals process for Security Guard Services Contractors. In accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5(b)2, Council approval of the proposed Agreement is required because the cumulative term of the contract exceeds three years.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

There is no additional impact to the General Fund. Funding for this contract has already been provided and is available in the Police Department's Contractual Services account. Approval of the recommendation in this report complies with the City's Financial Policies in that contract expenditures will be limited to the use of approved budgeted funds.

FINANCIAL POLICIES STATEMENT

The recommendation in this report complies with the City's Financial Policies.

The Office of the City Attorney has approved the Amendments as to form.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the Amendments to the Office of the Mayor for review and approval.
3. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to execute the Amendments upon Mayoral approval.

DISCUSSION

On June 25, 2015, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking qualified firms to provide Security Guard Services for the LAPD. The City reviewed the proposals and executed Agreements with the Contractors for a duration of three years, from February 21, 2017 to February 20, 2020.

On August 27, 2019, the Board approved the release of an RFP for Security Guard Services. **FIFTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. C-128953
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
AND
GSG PROTECTIVE SERVICES, CA INC.
(Formerly U.S. METRO GROUP, INC.)
FOR SECURITY GUARD SERVICES**

This FIFTH AMENDMENT to Contract No. C-128953 is made and entered into by and between the City of Los Angeles, California, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), acting by and through the Los Angeles Police Department (hereinafter referred to as the "LAPD"), and GSG Protective Services CA Inc., a California Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2017, the LAPD and the Contractor entered into Contract No. C-128953 ("Original Agreement") to provide professional security services and patrol for City facilities; excluding Department of Airports, Department of Water and Power, and Harbor Department facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was for three (3) years, which commenced on February 21, 2017 and expires on February 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment provided for the 1.9% wage rate adjustment for Fiscal Year 2017-18 approved by the LACERS Board, which was effective from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment provided for the 2.8% wage rate adjustment for Fiscal Year 2018-19 approved by the LACERS Board, which was effective from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 and changed Section 9, Standard Provisions of the Original Agreement to reflect the revised Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev 10/17) [v.3]; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment provided for a corporate name change by the Contractor from "U.S. Metro Group, Inc." to "GSG Protective Services CA Inc."; and

WHEREAS, the Fourth Amendment provided for the 7.55% wage rate adjustment for Fiscal Year 2019-20 approved by the LACERS Board, which is effective from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the LAPD wishes to extend the term of the Original Agreement for an additional two-year period, commencing as of February 21, 2020 to February 20, 2022, to allow time for the Department to complete the Request for Proposals process and selection of a contractor/s; and to allow time for the City to complete the Request for Proposals process and selection of a Contractor/s; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor's services are of a professional and occasional nature and the Contractor has been providing satisfactory services; and

WHEREAS, this Fifth Amendment is necessary for the Contractor to continue to provide professional security services under the Original Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the City and the Contractor hereby agree that the Original Agreement, as previously amended, be further amended as follows:

1. Extension of the Term of the Original Agreement. City and Contractor hereby agree that the term of the Original Agreement as set forth in Section 2.0 of the Original Agreement entitled "Term of the Agreement" is hereby extended for an additional two-year period, beginning February 21, 2020 through February 20, 2022, unless terminated as provided in Section 9.0 of the Original Agreement.

2. Modification of Section 9.0, Standard Provisions.

a. The first sentence of Section 9.0, Standard Provisions, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The Contractor shall comply with the Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3], attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference.

b. The following new Section 9.3 is added to the Original Agreement:

Contractor shall comply with Los Angeles Administrative Code ("LAAC") Section 10.50 et seq., "Disclosure of Border Wall Contracting." City may terminate this contract at any time if City determines that Contractor failed to fully and accurately complete the required affidavit and disclose all Border Wall Bids and Border Wall Contracts, as defined in LAAC Section 10.50.1. The required affidavit must be submitted online at www.labavn.org

3. Ratification. Due to the need for the Contractor's services to be provided continuously, the Contractor may have provided services prior to the execution of this Fifth Amendment. To the extent that said services were performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement, those services are hereby ratified.

4. Order of Precedence. This Fifth Amendment is intended to extend the term of the Original Agreement. In the event of an inconsistency between any of the provisions of this Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-128953 or all prior or current attachments, the inconsistency shall be resolved by giving previous attachments and/or amendments precedence in the following order:

- 1) Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-128953,
- 2) Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3],
- 3) Fourth Amendment to Contract No. C-128953,
- 4) Third Amendment to Contract No. C-128953,
- 5) Second Amendment to Contract No. C-128953,
- 6) First Amendment to Contract No. C-128953, and
- 7) LAPD Contract No. C-128953.

5. Except as herein amended or modified, all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

This Fifth Amendment includes four (4) pages and is executed in three (3) duplicate originals; each of which is deemed to be an original. The Original Agreement is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety into this Fifth Amendment.
