

**ORDINANCE NO. 187487**

An ordinance repealing three COVID-19 related laws: (1) exclusive period to shop for senior citizens and disabled (Ordinance No. 186587); (2) temporary protection of occupants of self-service storage facilities (Ordinance No. 186660); and (3) littering of personal protection equipment (Ordinance No. 186707).

DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 186587 is repealed.

Sec. 2. Ordinance No. 186660 is repealed.

Sec. 3. Ordinance No. 186707 is repealed.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


