Comments for Public Posting: As we move into fire season and evacuation needs may conflict with COVID19 requirements, we should consider: -Antibody and/or active virus testing in high fire danger areas should start now, prioritize the most vulnerable, and be as systematic as possible. Start with communities of lower income, as they tend to have the most cases and least access to tests, medical care, and evacuation options. -Hotel/motels should be recruited to serve as evacuation centers to avoid intra-family and community-to-community spread as well as community gathering points. There should be positive and non-positive options. They should accept chickens. -People should know their new evacuation center asap. -Landscapers should be recruited to mitigate dangers in the neighborhood areas where the Guard isn't operating and to ID properties that present risks.
