Good morning Genesis. Thank you for the frequent updates. These are very helpful. Can someone explain why there appears to be an effort to rush this through.

I realize that the holidays are coming and that this map must be approved by late December. However, the fact that this map was passed by the LAUSD Redistricting Committee by an 8 to 5 vote, after originally been accepted as one of two maps being considered by a 10 to 3 vote back on October 20th, seems to me a bit disturbing.

Map 1 was also offered as one of two maps, but on a 13 to 0 vote. Logically, one can conclude that Map 1 was more in line with the majority, rather than Map 2.

In any case, I would like the Ad-Hoc committee to get this email as part of the record. Myself and numerous members of SELA would like the committee to consider these facts, prior to making any final decision on this very important map.
