The Arleta Neighborhood Council does hereby adopt a resolution of a vote of no confidence in Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascon. Since his election, George Gascon has put into place radical procriminal and anti-prosecution policies. Some examples of these policies include:

A disregard for the rule of law:

He refuses to prosecute crimes – misdemeanors including resisting arrest are being declined or dismissed. He ignores the will of the voters by instituting no cash bail.

His directive on sentencing puts our communities in danger:

Sentences that do not fit the crime – Rejection of all special enhancement allegations.
