Comments for Public Posting: Submitted on behalf of Agudath Israel of California: On June 16th the Los Angeles City Council adopted a motion directing the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to identify \$100 to 150 million of reductions in the Los Angeles Police Department Budget for the purposes of reinvesting these funds into disadvantaged communities and communities of color. The report back to the City Council has now been made public. Despite assurances to the contrary, the proposal will seriously impact Public Safety. In addition, the proposed use of these funds is vague, far from thought out, and not directed toward improving police performance or redirecting provision of service currently provided by the police to other more appropriate entities. For these reasons we strongly feel that this proposal be defeated by the City Council and rethought in a way that will fulfill the goals of Police Reform without devastating the safety of the public. The following should be guiding principles for any proposal to address Police Reform: 1- Racial discrimination is a serious problem in our society. Despite improvements, many African Americans still fear harassment, bodily harm and even death when encountering police officers. This demands immediate and effective action to correct. 2- Such action should be well thought out so that it effectively addresses the problem. 3- Public safety is of paramount importance. Every neighborhood, no matter the income level, influence, or racial makeup deserves and wants protection so that people can live their lives without fear. Any proposal that compromises the safety of the public, should be rejected. The CAO/CLA proposal to the City Council fails to meet the above stated requirements and should be defeated. Please note the following deficits from the report itself: Public Safety: 1- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by \$16,631,000 with the actual number of sworn officers being 10,009 as opposed to the 10,103 budgeted for in 2020-21. This will prevent the Department from filling 94 sworn positions above the attrition of 495 officers. 2- The report aims to reduce civilian overtime for a reduction of \$2,000,000. This will reduce the Department's flexibility to assign civilian employees such as police service representatives and detention officers. 3- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by \$74,307,000 by reducing non-reimbursable sworn overtime. This will negatively impact

deployment due to officers using banked overtime to take time off. 4- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by \$5,000,000 as reduced funding for replacement vehicles. This will increase the fleet's out of service rate from 11% to 20%. 5- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by \$3,280,000 in expenditures for technology in record keeping and work stations. The antiquated existing systems increase response time. 6- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by \$5,000,000 for expense accounts. This covers such items as firearms, ammunition, and field equipment purchase. 7- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by close to \$26,000,000 by reducing hiring of sworn officers from 503 to 251. This will reduce the sworn deployment to 9,757 by June 30,2021. This will result in delayed response and the elimination of 35 basic car patrols. 8- The report aims to reduce the LAPD budget by close to \$9,000,000 by reducing civilian hiring from 145 to zero. This will result in many sworn officers being assigned to civilian duty. Use of the funds saved by reduction of the LAPD Budget: There are only general statements as to how these funds are to be allocated. The CAO and CLA are directed to report to the Council with recommendations on how to reinvest this money back to impacted communities. The following City agencies are being directed to report on programs that could support the equitable use of these funds, devise a community engagement strategy and a monitoring system to track the funds: 1-Economic and Workforce Development 2- Housing and Community Investment 3-Youth Development Taskforce 4-Recreation and Parks 5- Civil and Human Rights 6- Human Relations While these are all wonderful agencies, none of them deal with police reform or retraining. None are involved with restructuring the Department so that trained civilians respond to calls that don't require police force. None of them address the issues that this redirection of funds is meant to address. For the above reasons Agudath Israel of California feels that this motion should be defeated and a well thought out approach that addresses the serious issues of racial discrimination consistent with principles of good governance, be brought forward in it's place.
