BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the identification of cuts from the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) budget and recommendations on reinvesting these funds back into disadvantaged communities and communities of color.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Martinez - Wesson - Price - Rodriguez - Price for Krekorian):

- 1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst, (CLA) with assistance from the Mayor, work to identify at least \$100-\$150 million of cuts from the LAPD's budget.
- 2. INSTRUCT the CAO and the CLA to provide recommendations on an engagement process to seek input from disadvantaged communities and communities of color that would provide recommendations for the Council on the use of the City's General Fund and improvements to our public safety service delivery.
