## Area codes 408 and 669

Area codes 408 and 669 are telephone area codes in the North American Numbering Plan (NANP) in the U.S. state of California. The numbering plan area comprises most of Santa Clara County and Northern Santa Cruz County, and includes Gilroy, Morgan Hill, Saratoga, Los Gatos, Monte Sereno, Milpitas, Sunnyvale, Santa Clara, Cupertino, Campbell, and San Jose.

Area code 408 was split from area code 415 in 1959, and area code 669 was assigned to the same numbering plan area in an overlay plan in 2012.



As of 1950, the central and northern regions of California had been divided into two numbering plan areas (NPAs) along a south-north boundary, with area code 415 assigned to the coastal stretch, and 916 for the mountainous region in the east. [1]
