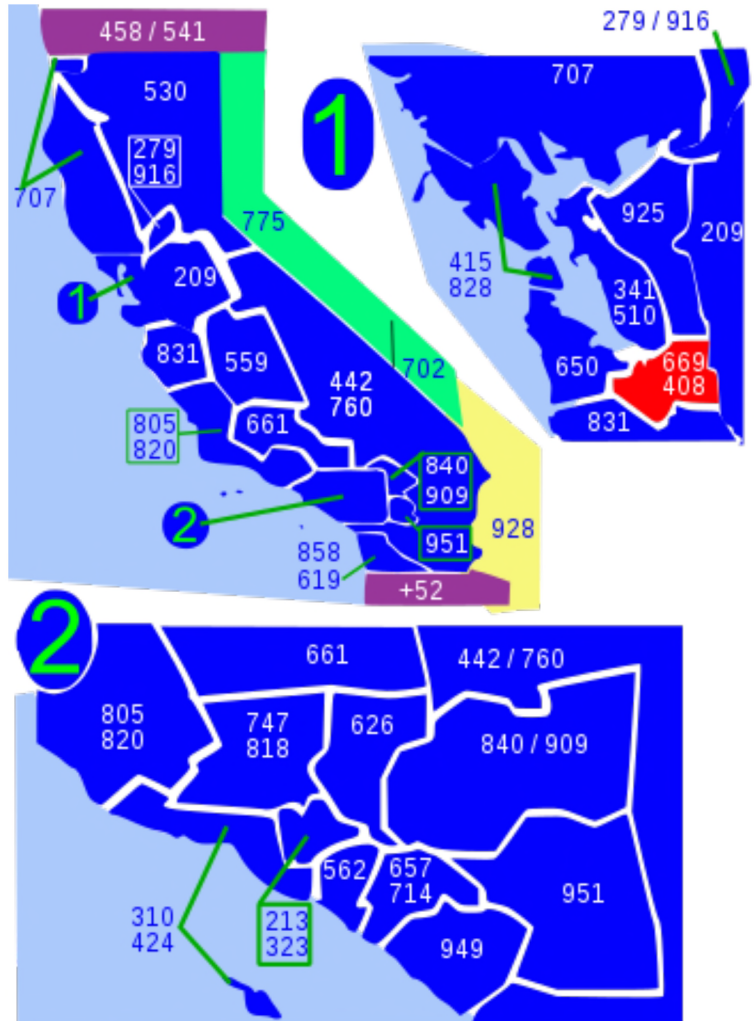

## History

As of 1950, the central and northern regions of California had been divided into two numbering plan areas (NPAs) along a south-north boundary, with area code 415 assigned to the coastal stretch, and 916 for the mountainous region in the east.<sup>[1]</sup>
