MOTION

In accordance with State Law, the City Clerk is compiling petitions to renew the Greater Chinatown Business Improvement District (BID). The BID area consists of approximately 30 blocks from Figueroa Terrace and the 110 (Pasadena) Freeway on the west to Cottage Home Street on the north, roughly North Main Street on the east and Cesar E. Chavez Avenue on the south. The BID provides such services as landscaping and beautification. The boundaries of the BID include both privately-owned parcels and six City-owned parcels. At this time, BID proponents have achieved 49.83 percent of the 50 percent threshold.

The City has previously supported BID formation efforts in areas where the City owns property. To allow these efforts to proceed, the Council should authorize the City Clerk to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels included in the BID.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council authorize the City Clerk, or designee, to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels included in the Greater Chinatown Business Improvement District in order to meet State requirements.
