**Comments for Public Posting:** Greetings, The Neighborhood Councils had questions based on publicly available information regarding what appears to be gross mismanagement of DONE funds. I draw your attention to Raquel Beltran's responses, most recently the 12 page report. 90% of Ms. Beltran's report, which BONC did NOT vote to approve, simply refers back to the same problematic publicly available information as though doing so were a good thing, rather than tantamount to an admission of the gross mismanagement. In the remaining 10%, Ms. Beltran, blames contract shifting and non/underperformance on the pandemic and the insurrection, even though those events occurred PRIOR to the enactment of the contracts in question. She also casts aspersion after aspersion, in a condescending, patronizing, unprofessional manner at the very individuals she is charged in her capacity of general manager of DONE to empower.
