Summary: The Encino Neighborhood Council voted against this motion unless amended. Whereas, the ENC recognizes and agrees with both PLUM and the movers of the motion in the need to combat corruption. However, The ENC believes that additional checks and balances are needed to combat possible future corruption in the planning and land use committees. Seeing as two councilmembers' have been indicted by the FBI for Planning and Land Use corruption, one being both on the City Council and Chair of PLUM, removing a layer of due diligence seems counterproductive. Whereas the ENC urges more due diligence in the face of possible corruption. The ENC suggests amending for a new check and balance to planning projects in general. The ENC suggests the use of a floating, voting seat on the APC/CPC/PLUM be created, allotted for the NC to which the project falls within. This special seat would only be filled by a certified NC member, elected by its NC., and will advocate for NC position regarding said project.
