Summary: CIS for Council file 20-1044 November 09, 2020 Whereas, the Mid City Neighborhood Council recognizes and agrees with both PLUM and the movers of the motion in the need to combat corruption. However, the MINC believes that additional checks and balances are needed to combat possible future corruption in the planning and land use committees. Seeing as two council members' have been indicted by the FBI for Planning and Land Use corruption, one being both on the City Council and Chair of PLUM, removing a layer of due diligence seems counterproductive. Whereas the MINC urges more due diligence in the face of possible corruption. Instead, of CF 20-1044 the MINC suggests a new check and balance to planning projects in general. The MINC suggests the use of a floating, voting seat on the APC (Area Planning Commission), CPC (City Planning Commission), Planning and LandUse Management Committee (PLUM) be created, allotted for the NC to which the project falls within.
