Good afternoon Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Please include this letter in the record for the council file and supplemental records.

Although the effort to help our unhoused neighbors is appreciated and welcomed, the location you have in mind is unsuitable, poorly thought out and illegal according to City of Los Angeles Charger 594(c).

This is once again a waste of taxpayer money and City resources.

The Hollywood Recreational Center (HRC) is the only one of its kind in Central Hollywood. This center provides community activities such as afterschool tutoring, various sports activities and a large field for children & adults to engage in sports/team-building activities. There are many residents that live in apartment buildings with no green spaces available period. Just because the HRC isn't being used due to COVID-19 restrictions doesn't mean that will always be the case. The community intends to make full use of our public spaces as soon as it is safe to do so. To take away the limited amount of outdoor space that exists in Central Hollywood is to tell all residents - housed and unhoused- that our quality of life can be substantially reduced at any time for any reason at the whim of a Councilmember.

The City's mishandling and mistreatment of our unhoused community will not be resolved by taking parks and recreation centers away from underserved and poorly represented neighborhoods
