PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed Amendment No. 4 to Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) in connection with the Community Safety Partnership Program (CSP).

## Recommendations for Council action:

- APPROVE Amendment No. 4 to the MOA between the HACLA and the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), attached to the Council file, as a part of the CSP Program with LAPD officers to be deployed and assigned to the eight public housing developments program sites of:
  - a. Ramona Gardens
  - b. Nickerson Gardens
  - c. Jordan Downs
  - d. Imperial Courts
  - e. Avalon Gardens
  - f. Gonzaque Village
  - g. Pueblo del Rio
  - h. San Fernando Gardens
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAPD, to execute Amendment No. 4, on behalf of the City, with the HACLA.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The Board of Police Commissioners (Board) reports that the HACLA will provide the LAPD an additional reimbursement sum up to \$875,000.00 to continue to operate the CSP Program during the extension period of July 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The total reimbursement sum under the MOA, Amendment Nos. 1 through 4, shall not exceed \$8,957,000.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## Summary:

On October 27, 2020, your Committee considered a September 15, 2020 Board report relative to proposed Amendment No. 4 to MOA with the HACLA in connection with the CSP. According to the Board, there exists a need in various public housing sites around the City of Los Angeles to increase "community livability," to help promote the safety, security and welfare of residents of the sites. The HACLA desires to continue a partnership with the LAPD to ensure dedicated, fulltime law enforcement resources in eight public housing developments. The LAPD values and supports the continuation of the CSP program policing model that relies on long-term

assignments of police personnel to the program sites. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of Amendment No. 4. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
