

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 61.07 to harmonize it with relevant state laws and legal authorities regarding identification for individuals employed as public officers by the City.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated November 25, 2020 to amend LAMC Section 61.07 to harmonize it with relevant state laws and legal authorities regarding identification for individuals employed as public officers by the City.

Summary:

On December 8, 2020, your Committee considered a November 25, 2020 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 61.07 to harmonize with relevant state laws and legal authorities regarding identification for individuals employed as public officers by the City. According to the City Attorney, on October 21, 2020, Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to amend the LAMC to harmonize the LAMC sections associated with public offers with relevant state laws and legal authorities regarding identification for individuals employed as public officers by the City. After consideration and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
