TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to assessing the Personal Delivery Devices (PDD) program and recommendations for improvement.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hernandez – Soto-Martinez):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation:

- 1. To report with an assessment of the PDD program and recommendations to improve the program, including but not limited to:
 - a. Evaluation of the current permit structure, with recommendations for alternative or supplemental models such as per-trip fees, utilization fees, and a tiered advertising fee schedule.
 - b. Review of deployment and operational practices.
 - c. Analysis on the enforcement responsibilities, and recommendations on enforcement management.
- 2. In consultation with the City Attorney, to report on the feasibility of leveraging data collected by PDDs to utilize to support the City's infrastructure data collection efforts.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 22, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered a September 19, 2025 Motion (Hernandez – Soto-Martinez) relative to assessing the Personal Delivery Devices (PDD) program and recommendations for improvement. According to the Motion, the City has not reassessed the outcomes or the fee structure since adoption of Ordinance No. 187715, which established the regulatory framework for the pilot program. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
