

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the proposed first amended and restated Agreement to Contract No. C-137882 between the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services to provide mental health call diversion services under the Call Direction to Ensure Suicide Safety Program (CRESS).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or designee, to negotiate and execute the First Amended and Restated Agreement to Contract No. C-137882 between the LAPD and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services to continue providing mental health call diversion services to the Department, that extends the term of the original agreement from February 10, 2021 through March 31, 2026.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the proposed First Amended and Restated Agreement to Contract No. C-137882 between the LAPD and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services will result in no additional impact to the General Fund. Funding will be provided by the Department through its Fiscal Year 2024-25 Contractual Services account. Funding for future years will be subject to the appropriation of funds in the annual budget process. Execution of the proposed contract amendment is in compliance with the City’s Financial Policies in that budgeted funds are used for its intended purposes and that the City’s obligation is subject to the availability of funding in each fiscal year.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation stated in this report complies with the City’s Financial Policies in that contract expenditures will be limited to the use of approved budgeted funds.
