The Petition will be filed in Los Angeles County Superior Court and will allege, inter alia, that the City failed to comply with CEQA when it determined that the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the Sidewalk and Transmit Amenities Program (“Project”) was legally sufficient under the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”). 
