Rodeo contestants are talented and not only is it fun for them, it is fun for the stock. It gives purpose to the animals from broncos to the little sheep in the muttonbusting. If it weren't for Rodeo, an enormous number of livestock would run wild. The United States themselves are having a hard time with the overpopulation of horses and burros running on open fields. They are diminishing the soil and vegetation they surround and the earth just can not grow it as fast as they eat it. Oveegrazing leads to starvation and depletion of proper growing soil. So in my eyes leaving horses wild is just as abusive. They have to fight to live, scavenge for resources, and try to adapt to freezing or burning hot temperatures. 
