This is because these animals are incredibly important assets to the community that continues to shine light on the animals importance to and history in and outside of rodeo. Men and women dedicate their lives to ensuring that all animals have the best lives and top of the line veterinary care in and out of the rodeo arena. There are always veterinarians on site of every rodeo affiliated event along with the care received by the contractors and owners of the animals involved. I have yet to see any organization give better care than these people have to their animals as they receive proper nutrition, live in environments with wide open pastures to graze and run, get regular hoof trimmings, health checks, prenatal and postnatal care and more. As a result these animals live long and happy lives as they enjoy life along with humane training, riding, and work that enriches their lives by providing great stimulation. There are also hundreds of agricultural and cattleman groups that dedicate their lives to ensuring that all of the animals involved receive only the best care by implementing several rules that must be followed by all rodeo associations and participants that work to ensure all activities are carried out with the safety and wellbeing of the livestock in mind. On top of these rules in the area the PRCA and other rodeo organizations will only get their livestock from proven ethical breeders and contractors. This has been true since the very first Spanish vaqueros were welcomed into the United States. Alongside them many Native American tribes have ushered in the tradition of rodeo and alongside it, the insistence that all of those involved, human and animal are respected and cared for properly. The traditional practices of horsemanship and rodeo have been passed down for generations from these groups and has become an integral part of many communities as cowboys of all creeds, races, and backgrounds join together with animals to preserve Native, Spanish, and western traditions.
