Summary: The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council (USORO NC") supports Council File 21-0002- S195 regarding the allocation of state funds for mental health beds in Los Angeles County. The current number of beds available for psychiatric treatment (1,700) does not meet the needs of LA County's homeless population. The county must increase the number of sub-acute beds where patients can live for a few days or a few months with psychiatric care provided to 7,000 in order to serve the number of homeless individuals with a clinical diagnosis of severe mental illness and to prevent the growing number of homeless deaths occurring on the streets. The SORO NC Strongly urges state senators and assembly members to introduce legislation to increase funding for mental health beds in LA County for all age groups regardless of medicare or medical coverage.
