The suspect fired multiple shots killing the victim. The suspect fled northbound on Figueroa Street to an unknown location. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not been able to identify any suspect or suspects. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person or persons responsible for this crime.
