**REVISED DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 151.09 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER XV AND SECTION 165.03 OF ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER XVI OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PUBLIC INTEREST TO AVOID FORFEITURE, LIMIT DISPLACEMENT AND HOMELESSNESS, AND RESTRICT EVICTIONS FOR NONPAYMENT OF RENT THAT IS NOT MATERIAL AS SPECIFIED; AND ADDING SECTION 165.10 TO ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER XVI OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCORPORATE A SEVERANCE CLAUSE**

Honorable Members:

On January 23, 2023, this Office transmitted a draft ordinance to prohibit evictions for nonpayment of rent until the tenant's rent debt exceeds a monetary threshold of one month of fair market rent. Pursuant to your request, we now transmit the enclosed revised draft ordinance to incorporate a severance clause into Article 5, Chapter XVI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.

CEQA Findings

This Office recommends that the City Council find that the adoption of this revised draft ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) through Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines and Article II, Section 1 of the City CEQA Guidelines. If you concur, you should adopt this finding prior to or concurrent with taking action on this revised draft ordinance.



Council Rule 38 Referral


