Hello,

I am a renter in Los Angeles County. I live here with my two young children. I am writing to urge you to include the unreasonable increase in a security deposit to the tenant resolutions that are being written.

My landlord has issued a notice saying she is increasing our rent by 10% and increasing our security deposit. Currently we pay \$2,750 a month and put down a \$2,750 deposit. She now wants the security deposit to equal two months of the new rent and is demanding that we put down an additional \$3,300.

We were small business owners who have been impacted by Covid-19. We don't have \$3,300 laying around to use toward a deposit. This can quite literally be the cause for us to be evicted.
