

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the proposed definitions, impacted entities, implementation schedules, and compliance approaches for a single-use printer cartridge ban.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. REQUEST the City Attorney, in coordination with Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) and based upon the information contained in the BOS report dated June 24, 2025, attached to the Council file, to prepare and present an ordinance prohibiting the sale of single-use printer cartridges.
2. INSTRUCT the BOS to report to the Energy and Environment Committee on its plan for a comprehensive public outreach campaign for this program prior to the City Attorney draft ordinance returning to the Energy and Environment Committee.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the BOS. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
