

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an In-Kind donation to the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) of VAYA Electrolyte packets, an electrolyte hydration solution.

Recommendations for Council action:

ACCEPT the In-Kind donation of VAYA Electrolyte packets from the LAFD Foundation valued at \$18,634.83; and, THANK the donor for their generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Fire Commissioners reports that there is no fiscal impact to the LAFD budget from the acceptance of this donation. Donations provide the necessary items meeting the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and LAFD business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.
