The address of the proposed development is 2520 North Eastern Avenue (2532, 2608, and 2668 North Eastern Avenue and 2647-2651 North Lombardy Boulevard). We need to call out Kevin de Leon and tell him that we need him to stand up for the community against this horrible project. This doesn't provide a single unit of low -income housing. These are market rate for sale units that will cost more than any of us can afford. It's time for us to say enough is enough.
