- On July 3, 2018 Councilman Joe Busciano volunteered the City of Wilmington as a potential location for Bridge Housing/Safe Parking(CF-180651) without prior community input from residents of Wilmington.
- On July 5th Mr. Busciano gave a press release of his intent. (Daily Breeze 07/05/18)
- On July 9th a meeting was held on that Monday morning at 10am in San Pedro to address this issue. A presentation was given by United Way detailing how the project will work but NOT A SINGLE REPRESENTATIVE was there from Mr. Buscaino's office.
- On July 12th, Coffee with a Cop meeting was held at Café Café in Wilmington to discuss the homeless shelter. AGAIN NO ONE from Mr. Buscaino's office was present.
- On July 18th, the Wilmington Neighborhood Council held a Special Board Meeting. NO ONE from Mr. Buscaino's office was there but we were advised Mr. Buscaino, his Chief of Staff Jacob Haik and his Field Rep for Wilmington Fernando Navarrete were ALL ON VACATION.
- Bridge Housing is temporary housing for the homeless. It includes room, board, pet care, storage, medical dental health and Psychiatric services as well as other city Services(United Way Presentation and Daily Breeze Article)
- Safe Park is free overnight parking for RV's and those who live in their car.(Joe Buscaino SAFE PARKING YouTube Video)
- Mr Busciano wants to build a LARGE Safe Park that will cover the ENTIRE Harbor area (Daily Breeze Article 07/05/18)
- Mr. Busciano wants to build BOTH Safe Park and Bridge Housing in Wilmington (Daily Breeze Article 07/05/18)
- Mr. Buscaino volunteered Wilmington and is determined to place these homeless facilities in Wilmington without proper input or notification to the community.(CF-180651)

- United Way Presentation in San Pedro says that these facilities will help LESS THAN 1/3 of the homeless population. There is no Plan for the other 70%.(United Way Presentation 07/09/18)
- The Proposed Property has numerous environmental restrictions on it. If this would be any other developer the property would be subject to numerous soil and ground tests, Environmental Impact reports. And Subject to the restrictions of the Mayor's own ordinance for clean up green up for heavily polluted areas. The property is in a Methane zone, as well as being less than a block away from a Coastal Zone. The property is also part of the Tidelands Trust. NONE of these guidelines are being followed as the city is EXEMPT from these restrictions. This poses serious environmental and health questions.(ZIMAS)
- No details have been provided to detail, the size, scope or length of this program. How many people? How many cars? How many pets?
- There is a conflict with regards to the type of security to be provided. Council President Wesson states it will be L..A.P.D, United Way says it will be Private Security. This is Port Property will it be the Port Police?
- Residents have had no say whatsoever and haven't even been given the opportunity to discuss alternate locations that might be better suited.
- No guidelines have been provided to detail what the qualifications are to participate in these programs
- No list of Security Measures have been provided to insure that guidelines are being met.
