If the Neighborhood Council chooses to do so, the Neighborhood Council representative must provide the Commission with a copy of the CIS or rResolution sufficiently in advance for review, possible inclusion on the agenda, and posting on the Commission's website. Any information you can provide related to your agenda setting schedule is helpful to share with the NC.

If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *listed on the Commission's agenda*, during the time the matter is heard, the designated Neighborhood Council representative should be given an opportunity to present the Neighborhood Council's formal position. We encourage becoming familiar with the City Council's rules on the subject. At the Chair's discretion, the Neighborhood Council representative may be asked to have a seat at the table (or equivalent for a virtual meeting) typically reserved for City staff and may provide the Neighborhood Council representative more time than allotted to members of the general public. They are also permitted up to five (5) minutes of time to address the legislative body. If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *not listed on the agenda*, the designated Neighborhood Council representative may speak during General Public Comments.

**TO SEND A LETTER TO CITY AND CIS OPPOSING COUNCILMEMBER YARASLAVSKY'S PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO LAMC 41.18.**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

**WLASNC has consistently supported LAMC 41.18 as a means of protecting sensitive uses in the public space from homeless encampments. The WLASNC has witnessed firsthand the difference between having protected City space, and having County land that is not protected by a similar ordinance, becoming the subject of long-standing, dangerous encampments. We oppose CF 21-0329-S5, as it will make implementation of LAMC 41.18 unnecessarily complicated and unnecessarily difficult, and needlessly involves County agencies in matters of City policy. LAMC 41.18 was never intended to solve the homelessness, but rather to protect the public space near sensitive uses, and we urge the City to not dilute what impact 41.18 has on protecting the public space near sensitive uses.
