## **MOTION**

I MOVE that the matter of the Energy, Climate Change, Environmental Justice, and River Committee Report relative to the Outreach Engagement Framework, consisting of emergency outreach, service-focused outreach, and sanitation outreach, to ensure a better chance of successful housing placement for people experiencing homelessness, Item No. 32 on today's Council Agenda (CF 21-0329), BE AMENDED to add the following instructions:

DIRECT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), in consultation with homeless service provider non-profits, Coordinated Entry System Outreach Coordinators, Los Angeles Homeless Service Authority Homeless Engagement Teams, the Bureau of Sanitation Outreach, the Mayor's Uniform Homeless Response Center, and appropriate LA County Department of Health, Mental and Public Health representatives to assess and report on the start-up phase of implementation of the Citywide Street Engagement Strategy and report back to the Homelessness and Poverty Committee in March 2022 on the results of the Street Engagement Strategy and lessons learned, including what went well, what did not go well, outstanding data collection/analyses needs, and if additional investments are needed to effectuate interim and permanent housing placements for unhoused residents being served by the Street Engagement Strategy.

DIRECT the CLA and CAO to work with Council Offices, the Mayor, and relevant City and County departments to continue to fund and sustain Citywide interim and permanent housing projects to ensure there are adequate resources to aid the unhoused individuals engaged through the Street Engagement Strategy into suitable interim and permanent housing.
