- b. Discuss and collaborate with environmental advocacy and environmental justice partners, such as but not limited to the Sierra Club, Physicians for Social Responsibility Los Angeles, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Locals 18 and 11; and, to include comment and suggestions on the next report card.
- c. Report and present their findings and recommendations at the conclusion of the LADWP's Strategic Long Term Resource Plan.
