

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authorizing the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) to execute a Sixth Amendment with Swinerton Builders, to provide construction services for the domestic baggage claim work at the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners (Board) that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article III, Class 1 (1) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE the Sixth Amendment to Contract DA-5305 with Swinerton Builders, to increase the contract authority by \$1,264,699, for new total not to exceed \$296,984,443, covering construction services for the domestic baggage claim work at LAX.
3. CONCUR with the Board's action on December 16, 2021, by Resolution 27396, authorizing the Chief Executive Officer, or designee, of LAWA to execute said Sixth Amendment to Contract DA-5305 with Swinerton Builders.
