DISCUSSION

This donation will fund the construction and installation of a pedestal for a K-9 Memorial Monument at Police Headquarters Facility (PHF). The granite pedestal will support the bronze K-9 sculpture that has been completed and is in storage at Metropolitan Division. The pedestal will be inscribed with the names of the Police Service Dogs that have been killed in the line of duty and will have a ceramic inlay portraying the Department's K-9 Unit logo. Approval of this grant will honor fallen K-9s, foster goodwill between the public and the Department, and add to the beauty of the PHF Plaza.

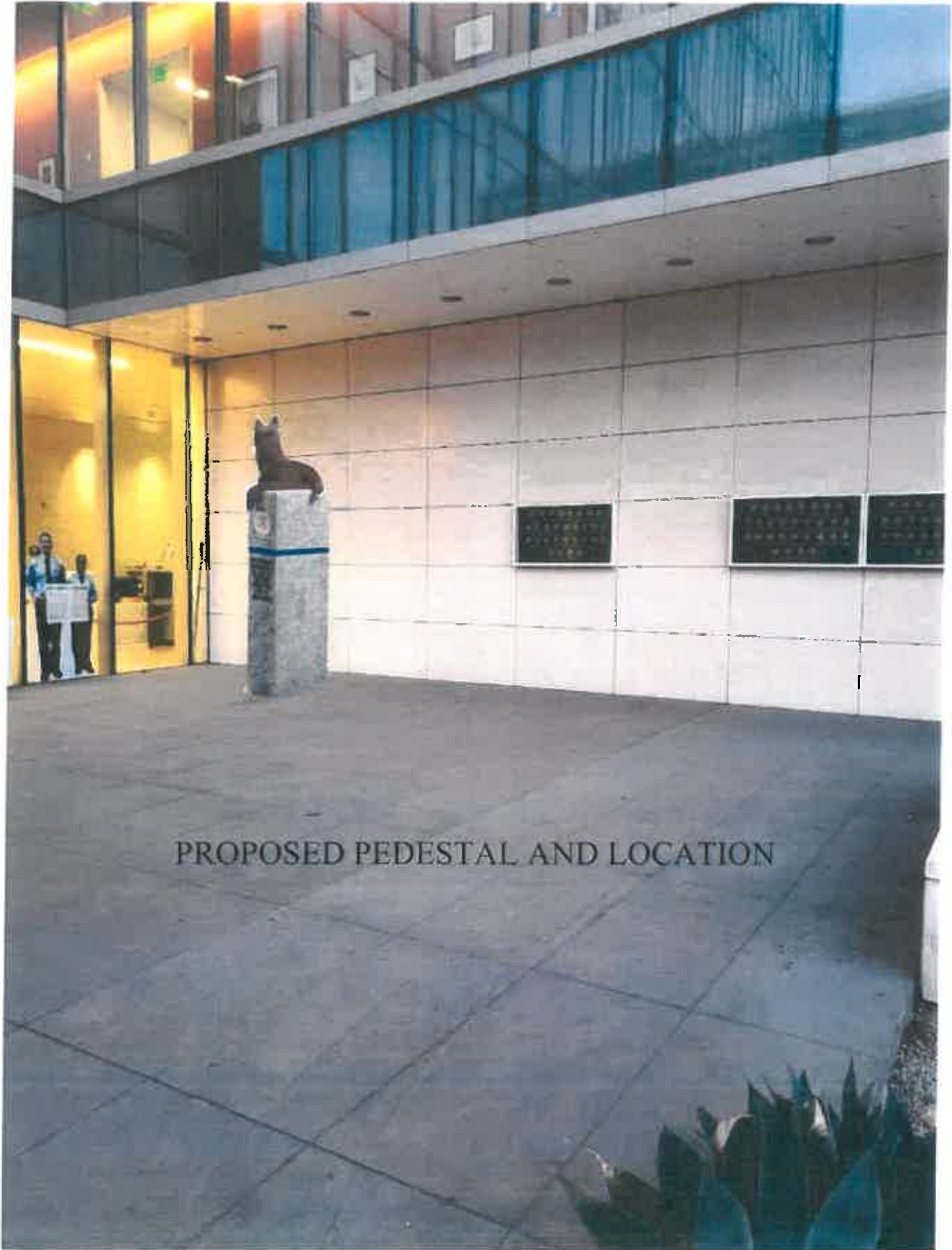

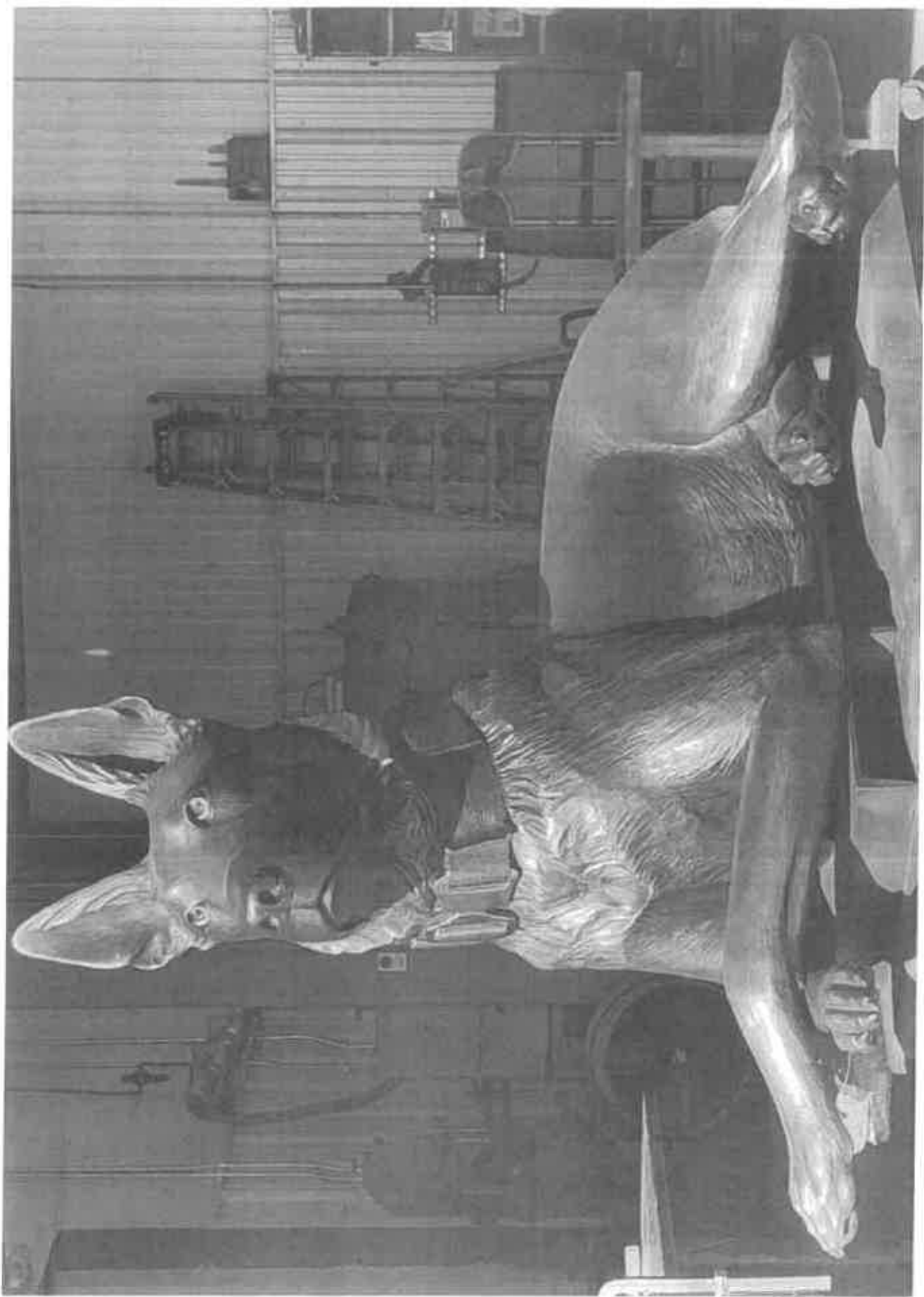

NAME OF GRANT: K9 Memorial Monument at Police Headquarters Facility

It is requested that Metropolitan Division's K9 Platoon be approved for an in-kind donation in the amount of \$25,000.00 for a K9 Memorial Monument at Police Headquarters Facility (PHF). The request includes the construction and installation of a pedestal for the K9 dog statue (see attached pictures). The pedestal will be used to display the bronze K9 sculpture that is completed and in storage at Metropolitan Division. The pedestal will be inscribed with the names of the police K9s that have been killed in the line of duty and will have a ceramic inlay portraying the LAPD K9 Unit Logo. Facilities Management Division (FMD) has provided approval of this project. The pedestal design will be presented to the Office of the Chief of Police for input and approval.

Police Service Dogs have dedicated their lives in the line of duty, and it is requested that their contributions be honored by a memorial monument. Aside from honoring the fallen K9s, the proposed monument will foster goodwill between the public and the Department. The LAPD K9s at community outreach events generate overwhelmingly positive feelings, so community members visiting PHF will certainly take notice of the monument. In addition, the proposed structure will add to the beauty of the Plaza.
