I MOVE that the Civil, Human Rights and Equity Department be authorized to use funds designated for a Racial Equity Baseline Study to instead conduct a Racial Equity Audit of existing City programs, policies, and practices and to develop a Strategic Action Plan that determines whether African Americans and other underserved communities face systemic barriers in accessing benefits and opportunities available across the City, and other programmatic objectives outlined in CF 21-0702 (the Racial Equity Audit and Strategic Action Plan); this authorization includes any other actions needed to perform the Audit, including a Request for Proposals, seeking philanthropic donations and processing and executing any needed documents for this purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
