relative to placing a ballot measure on the next available ballot in 2022 to add “City of Los Angeles” to the definition of "local" in Section 371a. of the City Charter.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield – Harris-Dawson – Koretz, et. al.):

REQUEST the City Attorney, in consultation with the Bureau of Contract Administration and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to prepare and present the documents necessary to place before the voters on the next available ballot in 2022, a measure to add "City of Los Angeles" to the definition of "local" in Section 371a. of the City Charter, so that the City could be permitted to have an additional contracting bid preference for businesses that are located in the City, consistent with other laws and constitutional limits on how far bid preferences can be implemented in the State of California.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

Summary:

On September 15, 2021, your Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield – Harris-Dawson – Koretz, et. al.) relative to placing a ballot measure on the next available ballot in 2022 to add “City of Los Angeles” to the definition of "local" in Section 371a. of the City Charter.
