I have lived in Benedict Canyon for more than 40 years and grew up in a different canyon just a few miles away. What I love about this area would be ruined by the hotel project that has been proposed. It is quiet here. It is full of wildlife. Deer, raccoons, bobcats and other animals roam these hills. All of this would be spoiled by a project that would draw hundreds of workers and guests each day, none of whom would have any incentive to care about the homes they were passing as they drove to and from the hotel. There is already terrible traffic in this canyon in the morning and the late afternoon - a project of this size would bring traffic to a standstill.

Benedict Canyon consists only of single family residences - no apartments, no commercial businesses. This is why my husband and I bought our home here and why my parents bought their home in a neighboring canyon. The community has the rhythm of single family homeowners - we get up in the morning, we go to work, we come home in the evening, we go to bed, we sleep through the night. A hotel, on the other hand, operates 24 hours a day. The noise and disruption would be continuous. There is no justification for changing the zoning in a way that goes against all the reasons we purchased our homes, especially when this zoning change would threaten the domestic rhythm of every other canyon.

Those who live in this community know that we live in a fire zone. I remember too well the Bel Air fire that took the homes of many of my friends in the 1960s. The biggest fire danger will come from strangers who don't understand that a single cigarette thrown from a car or dropped in the grass can destroy an entire neighborhood. Why would they care? They're only here for a night or two. We are not their neighbors. We are the people they pass by to get to and from a hotel.

For our safety and peace of mind, for the safety and peace of mind of everyone in every canyon, please approve the motion to stop the hotel project.
