ORDINANCE NO.	

An ordinance amending Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections 200.121, 200.122, and 200.124 through 200.129 to make the proof of COVID-19 vaccination requirements voluntary for Covered Locations, and to remove the requirements for proof of COVID-19 vaccination for Outdoor Large Events.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section. 1. Subsection K of Section 200.121 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is repealed.
- Sec. 2. Subsection L of Section 200.121 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by deleting the phrase "or Outdoor Large Event."
- Sec. 3. Subsection N of Section 200.121 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by deleting the phrase "Covered Location, City Facility, or Outdoor Large Event" and replacing it with the phrase "Covered Location or City Facility."
- Sec. 4. Subsections L through O of Section 200.121 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code are re-lettered K through N, respectively.
- Sec. 5. Section 200.122 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

SEC. 200.122. PROOF OF VACCINATION FOR A PATRON TO ENTER INDOOR PORTION OF A COVERED LOCATION.

A Covered Location may require each Patron to provide Proof of Vaccination or Proof of Negative COVID-19 Test upon entering an Indoor Portion of a Covered Location.

- Sec. 6. Sections 200.124 and 200.125 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code are repealed.
- Sec. 7. Sections 200.126 through 200.129 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code are re-numbered 200.124 through 200.127, respectively.
- Sec. 8. **Urgency Clause**. The City Council finds and declares that this ordinance is required for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, and safety for the following reasons: In light of the Health Officer Order issued by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health on March 3, 2022, clarifying and updating the requirements of the ordinance requiring proof of COVID-19 vaccination in certain

locations, which became effective November 8, 2021, the need for the City to harmonize its law is a subject of imminent concern. For all these reasons, the ordinance shall become effective upon publication pursuant to Los Angeles Charter Section 253.

Sec. 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
