Re: Covid Restrictions

Until early 2021, there was no vaccine available, so that efforts to counteract the pandemic were centered primarily around social distancing and masking. Since earlier this year, vaccines became available, and, though not perfect, have become the primary and by far the most effective means to combat the pandemic along with wearing a mask.1

The only way to bring the pandemic to an end is herd immunity. Any strategy that does not have as its endpoint herd immunity will fail. If everyone eligible for the vaccine had become vaccinated, we might well have reached herd immunity by now.<sup>2</sup> But our present approach is not working. Everyone has heard multiple times why it is important to get vaccinated, but to no avail. As long as the virus is allowed to fester and mutate in the unvaccinated, it cannot be defeated.3

Realistically we can probably expect more mutated strains, each potentially more virulent and/or contagious than the last.<sup>4</sup> The vaccines appear to be still highly effective against the Delta mutation, but there is no guarantee that they

will remain so against future mutations.<sup>5</sup> With each increase in the contagiousness of the virus, the percentage of the population that needs to be vaccinated in order to achieve herd immunity increases.

As a result, our policy is being driven, de facto, by the unvaccinated few, but the consequences are suffered by everyone. The virus does not dither. It is at work 24/7, spreading, killing, mutating.

Of the unvaccinated, the clear majority are better described as vaccine hesitant, as opposed to vaccine resistant. The hesitant present an opportunity, as there are probably enough them that, if vaccinated, herd immunity could be achieved.

Other jurisdictions have recently adopted policies, <sup>6 7 8</sup> such as the federal government, the city of San Francisco, and France and Italy, which seem to be working so far, and which curtail the ability of the unvaccinated to enter indoor facilities.<sup>9 10</sup>The Los Angeles City Council has pending before it a similar motion, that should be adopted. Council File: 21-0878. <sup>11</sup>

We therefore urge you to consider the steps outlined below. These should be taken as suggestions, not necessarily policies that Los Feliz Neighborhood Council endorses. Policies need to be evaluated in terms of their medical and scientific efficacy, as well as enforceability and legality. What the Los Feliz Neighborhood Council wants to emphasize is that we must take drastic new steps if we are to bring the pandemic to an end.

Tinkering with our present policies is not going to be enough.

Therefore, we urge both the City and the County to consider the following:

1. Certain indoor facilities, which are particularly likely to spread the virus, such as bars, restaurants, theaters, and the like, could be required to deny admittance to any person who cannot provide proof of their vaccination status, a la Council File: 21-0878.
