REVISED DRAFT ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 55.22 TO ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER V OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION, PURCHASE, SALE, RECEIPT, OR TRANSPORT OF A NON-SERIALIZED UNFINISHED FIREARM FRAME OR RECEIVER, OR NON-SERIALIZED FIREARM, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS

## Honorable Members:

This Office previously transmitted a draft ordinance to add Section 55.22 to Article 5, Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, which would prohibit within the City of Los Angeles the possession, receipt, transport, purchase, sale, and/or transfer of an unfinished firearm frame, unfinished firearm receiver, or firearm, that has not been properly imprinted with a serial number.

At its November 3, 2021, meeting, the Public Safety Committee requested that this Office strike the second sentence of the "Penalty" provision of Subdivision (c) that was contained in the original draft ordinance, leaving only the first sentence of that subdivision. This Office has therefore revised Subdivision (c), and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, which incorporates the Public Safety Committee's requested change.
