



DISCUSSION

This donation will fund the purchase of a collapsible Level III Mobile Bunker Shield for the Metropolitan Division's Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team. This system is specifically designed to provide mobile and maneuverable ballistic protection in areas where there is a lack of cover or armored vehicles are precluded from entering. Approval of this grant will directly benefit the members of the SWAT team by enhancing officer safety through ballistic protection that would otherwise be unavailable.

The Los Angeles Police Foundation is an independent, not-for-profit organization that provides critical resources and vital support to the Los Angeles Police Department. From essential equipment and state-of-the-art technology to specialized training and innovative programs that would otherwise be unfunded, the Foundation provides funding that directly improves public safety, impacts officer readiness, and enhances the quality of life of all members of the community. 
