

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the creation and implementation of a window sticker program to reward businesses who add green bin service and mitigation of cost increases associated with adding commercial green bin service and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman – Yaroslavsky):

1. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to report within 60 days with options for commercial accounts to mitigate cost increases associated with adding commercial green bin service with said analysis to include:
 - a. Waiving of expensive waste fees, such as distance fees and gate fees, for commercial accounts who are in compliance with the bill.
 - b. Helping commercial account holders recalibrate their waste removal by reducing black bin service to make up for the new green bin service.
 - c. Developing a RecycLA "base rate" structure that includes organics collection (green bin service), in addition to solid waste (black bin service) and recycling (blue bin service).
2. INSTRUCT the BOS to report within 60 days regarding the creation and implementation of a window sticker program to reward businesses who add green bin service, and recognize them for their efforts in being compliant with SB 1383.
3. INSTRUCT the BOS to report on a quarterly basis on City-wide compliance of SB 1383 so that Council may know the success of the program and if any additional help or incentives are needed to ensure its success.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

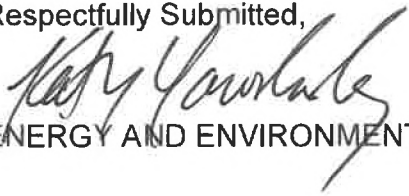
Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
